



## Michigan Math & Science Academy 2020 Continuity of Learning Schedule

### Middle School (6th-8th) & High School (9th-12th) Daily Schedule and Live Sessions

As you know, the Governor's Executive Order asks that the school year continue with distance learning for the remainder of the year. All schools were instructed to develop a plan to communicate to families on how we would be moving forward with the school year. During the mandated school closure, MMSA's goal is to provide students with routines and structures to help them stay engaged and connected. We understand that learning from home is a big change for most students and educators. The provided distance learning plan is in place to minimize instructional loss.

We are now in the 4th quarter of the school year. Students are expected to complete work to get credit for this quarter which will be reflected on report cards. We are trying to be as understanding as we can with our families and their unique circumstances. Continue to reach out to us if any situations arise that would hinder your child's learning.

**Learning Tools:** Teachers will utilize Google Classroom to send and receive work. If you are still without that information please contact your student's teacher. Google Classroom should work on a phone or tablet. We are doing our best to get devices ASAP, to families that still need them.

**Live Sessions:** Teachers will do Live Sessions at least once a week where they can video chat with students, support them in their work and do check ins. Attendance will be taken during the live sessions. Parents will be contacted if a student does not attend. Live sessions will be recorded for viewing by those who cannot meet at the scheduled time, or re-watching to review as needed.

**Communication:** Teachers will share their individual Office Hours. Feel free to email staff anytime.

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#### Summary:

- Each session will start with a live session (zoom, Hangouts, and GMeet), for your teacher to introduce a lesson, check in, and answer any questions students may have.
- Once the live session is complete, students have the remaining of the time to work independently on their assignment.
- Students should try to complete and submit their assignment on the set day of the week.
  - If students need more time, they can use the make-up day on Friday.
  - All assignments are due before the next week's session.
  - Middle School Only (double blocks of English and Math) - Students will complete 2 assignments a week or 1 large assignment
- Attendance will be taken during the live sessions.
- Live sessions will be recorded.
- Teachers will have office hours where they are available to work one on one with students who need more time and assistance.

#### MMSA Expectations:

- Students in middle school are expected to spend approximately 200 minutes/3.5 hrs a day learning (Online & Offline).
- Students in high school are expected to spend approximately 300 minutes/5hrs a day learning (Online & Offline).
